

Council Minutes
September 2, 2025
Special Called Meeting

The Pinson City Council met for a Special Called meeting at Pinson City Hall at 4410 Main Street, Pinson, on Tuesday, September 2, 2025, for the purpose of canvassing the election results.

Roll Call: Marie Turner City Clerk, called Roll of Pinson City Council with the following members present:

Mayor Roberts stated we received one Provisional vote, and the Board of Registrars has informed us this vote is to be counted.

Mayor Roberts opened the sealed Provisional Box and retrieved 1 Provisional envelope, opened and read the ballot results as follows: Mayor- 1 vote for Hoyt Sanders; Place 1- 1 vote for Tracie Thompson; Place 3- 1 vote for Dawn Minot Tanner; Place 5- 1 vote for Noel B. Holt.

Councilor Kirkland offered a resolution for canvassing election results, regarding the office of Mayor. Dezmond Boudreaux total votes-67; George “Robbie” Roberts, Jr. total votes-190; Hoyt Sanders total votes-412. Hoyt Sanders received the majority of the votes cast and is hereby duly elected for the term beginning on the first Monday in November 2025. Councilor Walker duly seconded the motion. Mayor Roberts called for all in favor say ‘aye’, all opposed say ‘no’.

Mayor Roberts, “let the record reflect the resolution passes as Resolution 25-20”.

Councilor Walker offered a resolution for canvassing election results, regarding the office of Council Place 1. Clinteshia Irvin total votes-228; Tracie Thompson total votes-425. Tracie Thompson received the majority of the votes cast and is hereby duly elected for the term beginning on the first Monday in November 2025. Councilor Kirkland duly seconded the motion. Mayor Roberts called for all in favor say ‘aye’, all opposed say ‘no’. **Mayor Roberts, “let the record reflect the resolution passes as Resolution 25-21”.**

Councilor Churchwell offered a resolution for canvassing election results, regarding the office of Council Place 3. Angelica Jefferson total votes-234; Dawn Minot Tanner total votes-402. Dawn Minot Tanner received the majority of the votes cast and is hereby duly elected for the term beginning on the first Monday in November 2025. Councilor Walker duly seconded the motion. Mayor Roberts called for all in favor say ‘aye’, all opposed say ‘no’. **Mayor Roberts, “let the record reflect the resolution passes as Resolution 25-22”.**

Councilor Walker offered a resolution for canvassing election results, regarding the office of Council Place 5. Chris Esquire total votes-114; Noel B. Holt total votes-283; Glenda Kirkland total votes-241. Noel B. Holt received the most and second most votes cast for Place 5, therefore a runoff election between Noel B. Holt and Glenda Kirkland is hereby ordered to be held on Tuesday September 23, 2025, pursuant to the requirements of Section 11-46-20 et.seq., of the Alabama Code of 1975 as amended. Councilor Kirkland duly seconded the motion. Mayor Roberts called for all in favor say 'aye', all opposed say 'no'. **Mayor Roberts, "let the record reflect the resolution passes as Resolution 25-23"**.

Mayor Roberts declared a Runoff election to be held September 23, 2025.

Councilor Walker offered a motion to adjourn the meeting. Councilor Churchwell duly seconded the motion. Mayor Roberts called for all in favor say 'aye', all opposed say 'no'. **Mayor Roberts, "let the record reflect the 'ayes' carry, and we are adjourned"**.
